WARRANT DATED 12th OCTOBER 1762



Palladian Lodge is the oldest lodge in the province of Herefordshire. The lodge was formed in 1762 (12 years after the formation of Grand Lodge) and meetings were held in the White Hart in Broad Street, it then moved to the familiar Green Dragon Hotel. Over the ensuing years the lodge met at various venues finally settling in the Masonic Hall, Kyrle Street where we meet today.

We meet once a month on the first Thursday from October to May, the business meeting commences at 6:00pm and ends at approximately 7:30pm. We then have a Festive Board which includes a 3-course meal, our evenings usually conclude at 9:30pm.

Our lodge membership is made up from various walks of life such as, Police Officers, HM forces personnel, Dentists, officer workers, electricians and heating engineers to mention just a few. The current lodge membership is 51.
